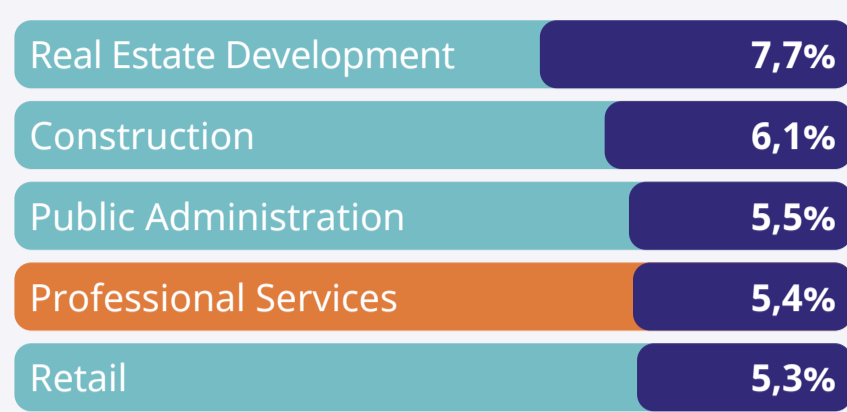

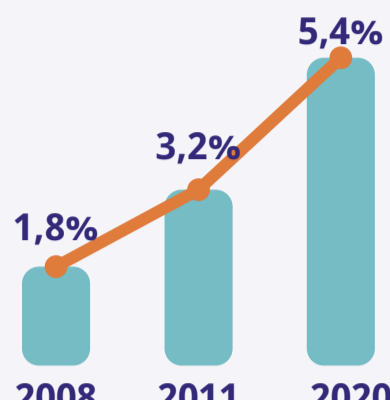


The top 5 industries in Romania in 2020

In Romania, the Professional Services sector has experienced a substantial growth over time, increasing by almost 70% compared to 2011 and by 200% compared to 2008.

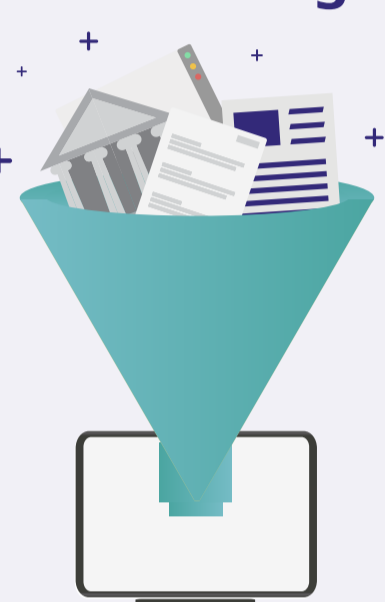

1. Managing multiple entities



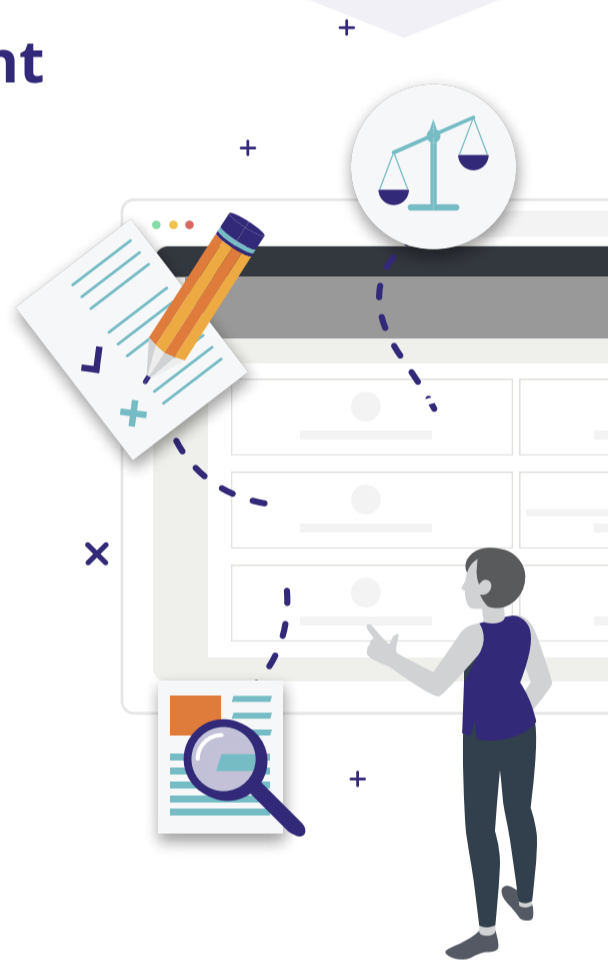

3. Flexible invoicing of projects and optimization of cash flow



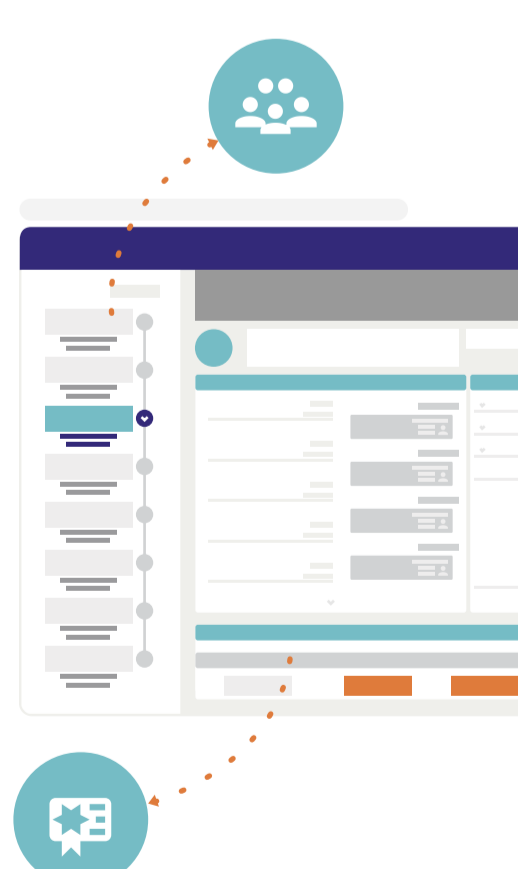
